Installing Sarah

Follow these steps to install Sarah:

- 1) Read the LICENSE file. :)
- 2) Copy the Sarah application icon to your Mac Applications folder, just like any other Mac application.
- 3) Copy the “Sarah” folder to your home directory. For instance, my home directory is “/Users/Al”, so after copying this folder, I have a new folder named “/Users/Al/Sarah”. (I’ll put this folder in a new location in the future, but for now, that’s how it works.)
- 4) Now, the hardest thing you have to do is edit a data file under that Sarah folder. In that Sarah folder there is a folder named “data”, and in that folder there’s a file named “sarah.config.xml” that you need to edit. Just right-click that file, click “Open With...”, select “Other...”, and then in your Applications folder, choose the TextEdit editor.

On line 95 of that file, you’ll see this text:

```
/Users/Al/Sarah/data
```

You just need to change “Al” in that line to the name of your home directory folder. For instance, if your username on your Mac is “Fred”, change that line to:

```
/Users/Fred/Sarah/data
```

After doing this, save the file, and close the editor.

- 5) At this point you can start Sarah, but I strongly encourage reading the User’s Manual. I’ve intentionally made that manual short so you can read it all in just a few minutes.
